

SLA INTERACTION PASSPORT GAME
OFFICIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. A PURCHASE OR DONATION WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING. SUBJECT TO ALL APPLICABLE FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL LAWS, REGULATIONS AND ORDINANCES. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED.

ELIGIBILITY: Participation in the InterAction Passport Game ("Game") is limited to Special Libraries Association ("SLA") registered 2009 Annual Conference attendees. Entrants must be twenty-one (21) years of age (the age of majority) or older as of Wednesday, June 17, 2009. Registered SLA 2009 Annual Conference Exhibitors, SLA Board Members, and the affiliates, subsidiaries, representatives, consultants, contractors, legal counsel, advertising, public relations, promotional, fulfillment, and marketing agencies of such Exhibitors or Board members (collectively, "Excluded Participants") and the immediate families (parent, child, spouse or sibling and their respective spouses, regardless of where they reside, and those living in their same households, whether or not related) of Excluded Participants are not eligible to enter or win. SLA reserves the right to verify the eligibility of winners. By entering, the entrant certifies the entrant's eligibility and agrees to be bound by these Official Rules and Regulations and the decisions of SLA, which are binding and final on all matters relating to the Game.

SPONSOR: The Game Sponsor, the Special Libraries Association, is located at 331 South Patrick Street Alexandria, Virginia 22314-3501.

TO ENTER: The Game starts at 1:00 p.m. Eastern Time ("ET") on Sunday, June 14, 2009 and ends at 2:00 p.m. ET on Wednesday, June 17, 2009 (the "Entry Period"). To enter, obtain at least twenty-five (25) different SLA 2009 Annual Conference Exhibitor Passport Stamps in the designated SLA Game Passport during the Game period, as described below. Each SLA 2009 Annual Conference attendee will receive a Game Passport in his or her conference tote bag. During the SLA INFO-EXPO Exhibit Hall hours, Game participants may obtain Exhibitor Passport Stamps. Each SLA 2009 Annual Conference Exhibitor will write their company name and

booth number on Game Passport Stamps and provide one (1) Passport Stamp to each attendee that visits their booth. Once all twenty-five (25) Passport Stamps are obtained, the attendee must place the completed Game Passport in the ticket tumble located at booth 1451 by 12:00 p.m. ET on Wednesday, June 17, 2009, thereafter at the Closing General Session by 2:00 p.m. Entries must be received by this deadline to be eligible. Limit of one entry per person during the Entry Period. . Any attempt by any participant to obtain more than the stated number of plays and/or entries by using multiple and/or different identities, game pieces, or other methods will void that participant's plays and/or entries, and that participant may be disqualified at SLA's discretion. All entries become the exclusive property of SLA and will not be returned.

DRAWING: The winner will be announced on Wednesday, June 17, 2009 during the SLA 2009 Annual Conference Closing General Session. The selected individual must be present to win. One (1) potential Grand Prize winner will be selected in a random drawing held on Wednesday, June 17, 2009 from among all eligible entries received. Odds of winning a prize depend on the number of eligible entries received. If SLA is unable to contact a potential winner within a reasonable time period (5 minutes) or a potential winner is not in compliance with these Official Rules and Regulations, or in the event a potential winner is disqualified for any reason, the prize will be forfeited and, at SLA's discretion, an alternate winner will be selected by the method described above.
