RE: Leadership Summit 2007 Report

The Leadership Summit will be held in Reno, NV Jan. 24 – 27 at John Ascuaga's Nugget Hotel. The tentative schedule of events appears at the end of this document. There will be a keynote speaker on Thursday and Friday morning.

Thursday we will hear from Chip Heath, Chip is the co-author (along with his brother, Dan) of a book entitled Made to Stick: Why Some Ideas Survive and Others Die. The book will be published by Random House in January 2007. Chip and his brother have taught and consulted on the topic of "making ideas stick" with audiences from Nissan, Chronicle Books, Ideo, and West Point, among others. His talk is titled Made to Stick: The Six Hooks of Successful Ideas.

Friday will bring Ken Haycock, Ken has provided leadership training for a wide range of personnel at all levels of the organization, from novice to CEO and is current Dean at the San Jose State University School of Library and Information Science. His talk is "Leadership and You: Tackling the Dragon." Leadership is no longer an option. Know yourself, know your environment and tackle the leadership dragon to make the connections for the change and resources you need to be successful. Begin with your Association, where you enjoy the support and understanding of colleagues and then extend your value and influence into your own organization.

This year's summit has many of the elements of the last few years with the first day being mostly general leadership skills and training and the second being leadership in SLA. There are a few changes to this year's program. The Meet and Mingle held on the Wednesday evening before the summit starts will be in a function room rather than the hotel bar. It is hoped it will provide a more welcoming environment for attendees and it will be from 5:30 pm -7:00 pm. The time change will allow attendees to make dinner plans, perhaps with fellow attendees from the Meet and Mingle and it will allow the Seattle planners to meet without missing the kickoff introductory meeting. The candidates lunch usually planned for Friday will be at annual conference in June so the Friday lunch will have a presentation on the new Association Management System that will bring many benefits to members.

The Board of Directors Meetings are scheduled for Wednesday, 24 Jan from 8:00 AM – 5:00 PM and on Saturday, 27 Jan from 8:30 AM – 4:30 PM. These time may be adjusted at the discretion of President Vargha.

The early- bird Registration fee for the summit is \$199 for members and \$300 for non-members by Dec. 22 and \$249 for members and \$350 for non-members after the the cut off date.
